Why might Childsmile change?

We have looked at different ways to save money.



If there are changes to the Childsmile programme this will save money.

£109,000





Changing the Childsmile programme would save £109,000.

The law says that we must provide some services to people that need help with health and social care. This could be services like home care.

There is no law that says we must have a service like the Childsmile programme. It is a national programme to help children have better teeth now and in their future.

If we do not make savings, we may not have enough money to run the services that the law tells us to.

What is the Childsmile Programme?



The Childsmile programme helps children and families learn how to look after their teeth.



They help by teaching school and nursery children how to brush their teeth properly



They help by visiting families at home to give them support.

This is the part of the programme that may change.



What could happen if the Childsmile programme changes?



Families may not get the help they need at home to keep their children's teeth healthy.



Some children may not get the support they need to look after their teeth before there is a problem. They may need to have teeth removed because of this.



Health Visitors will still help families with toothbrushing during three of their visits but extra support will not be available for families with this.



The Childsmile staff who visit families at home will be supported to get another job in the HSCP or board

How would people be supported if the Childsmile programme changes?



Health visitors will continue to talk to families about tooth brushing at key home visits.



Children will still be supported at school and nursery to brush their teeth.



Families will be given advice on how to register with a local dentist.



The HSCP will continue to check on children's dental health.





What will happen next?



There are events in June. You can have your say about the proposal to make changes to the Childsmile programme.



What people tell us will help the Integrated Joint Board to decide about the changes to the Childsmile programme.



The IJB will make a decision at a meeting in September 2025.



If they decide to change the Childsmile programme, this will happen from October 2025.
